Bylaws Change

At the April Executive Board meeting, the MHSLA Executive Board considered a Bylaws amendment suggested by the Bylaws Committee to change the number of nominees the Nominating Committee must select for the Annual slate.

The Executive Board preferring that MHSLA members always have a choice when they select their officers did not approve of this suggested amendment. Rather, they directed that the membership be given the opportunity to consider the pros and cons of this possible change via the medium of the Newsletter and requested that thinking about this important issue be stimulated by a commentary in the summer Newsletter.

In Article V, Section 1, D the MHSLA Bylaws presently direct the Nominating Committee to "prepare annually a slate of at least two (2) nominees for each office."

Nominating Committees take their responsibilities very seriously and look for the very best people they can find among the membership before they ask anyone to run for an Executive Board Office. Finding good candidates who are willing to run for office, particularly for the office of President Elect, can be difficult. In recent years some MHSLA Nominating Committees have found this to be a very difficult task.

Many successful organizations do not specify in their Bylaws, that there be two candidates for each office. Some, like the Michigan Chapter of SLA, specify one person per office. A proposal to change the number of nominees would not prohibit the Nominating Committee from preparing a slate of more than one nominee per office. It would merely give them that option. In addition the option to Nominate by petition always remains as a safety backup if organization members would like to nominate additional candidates.

Assuming that most Nominating Committees would abide by the minimum requirements of the Bylaws, this change may result in a slate of one nominee per office in the future years. Obviously, one candidate per office will be easier to obtain, while at times two per office can be difficult.

The question to be considered, then, is do we, as (continued on page 2)

members, always desire a choice of two candidates, or are we willing to accept the judgement of the Nominating Committee in years when sufficient candidates are hard to find.

Even though the Bylaws Committee will not present this proposal at the Annual Meeting in October, a change to permit the Bylaws to be ammended to read "prepare a slate of one or more nominee(s) for each office" can be considered if anyone makes such a motion during the Bylaws discussion at the meeting.

Another possibility would be for the membership to direct the Executive Board to study and evaluate a change to the Bylaws in regard to the number of candidates necessary on the Annual Slate.

MHSLA Call For Committees

MHSLA is in need of volunteers to serve on committees for the coming year. Committees which have openings are listed below with a brief description of their function. Please become active in your Association by volunteering to work on a committee.

BYLAWS — The Bylaws Committee studies the organization's bylaws to ensure that they meet present needs and safeguard the integrity of MHSLA. Bylaws are changed often to add new committees, clarify roles, change policies, etc.

EDUCATION — The Education Committee is charged with identifying and meeting the educational needs of the membership. The Committee identifies, recruits and manages arrangements for all speakers at the annual conference.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN — The ILL Committee works with all aspects of the interlibrary loan network, including DOCLINE, standards and guidelines. A bylaws amendment is being proposed to merge with the Union List Committee.

LEGISLATION — The Legislation Committee identifies, communicates and responds to legislative issues which may affect medical libraries.

PUBLICATIONS — The Publications Committee maintains the computerized mailing and membership lists of MHSLA, publishes the *MHSLA News* and prepares the annual membership directory.

TECHNOLOGY — The Technology Committee serves a clearinghouse function on library applications of new technology. They submit a column to the *MHSLA News* and assist with educational workshops on technological topics.

UNION LIST OF SERIALS — The Union List Committee is responsible for overseeing the production, distribution and maintenance of MISHULS. A bylaws amendment is being proposed to merge with the Interlibrary Loan Committee.

Fall Conference News

Downtown Kalamazoo will be the site of MHSLA's 14th Annual Educational Conference, to be held at the Hilton Inn from October 13 to 16, 1987. The conference will begin with an Open Forum discussion of future directions for MHSLA. Charles R. McClure will present the Keynote Address, "Strategies for Managerial Excellence: Future Challenges" following Wednesday's Business Meeting. Additional management topics will include "Planning and Evaluation of Library Services", also by Dr. McClure; "Quality Assurance", a seminar by Linda Wilcox; "Building Effective Working Relationships", with Penny Griffith; "How to Say Things to People" and "Time Management", presented by Judy Hallas; and "Management Databases/BRS", with BRS' Diane Daley.

"Basic Medical Library Information", a workshop for the paraprofessional/new professional, will again be presented by June Cronenberger. Daria Shackelford and Dina Nameth will lead a writing workshop; patient information and library automation will be the subjects of short contributed papers. "Rounding out" the session is a DOCLINE roundtable discussion. Friday's schedule features two full-day Continuing Education courses: #454, Oncology: Concepts and Resources, with Janet Watson of UCLA Biomedical Library; and #456, Advanced Skills for Online Searchers, with Helen-Ann Brown, MCRMLP Online Services Coordinator at McGoogan Library of Medicine, Omaha.

In addition to lectures, seminars, and discussions, registrants will have the opportunity to tour Upjohn Pharmaceutical Company's Manufacturing Plant and Corporate Technical Library, attend a local theater presentation of *The Music Man*, "aerobicize" at the crack of dawn at Hilton's poolside, and socialize at formal and informal gatherings for luncheon, dinner, and cocktails. DOCLINE

The following is abstracted from *Rapid Routing* by Irene Lovas of the Pacific Southwest Regional Medical Library Service.

"Switching to DOCLINE after having initially accessed the MEDLINE file is not a cost effective means of using the system. The user is charged for connect time in DOCLINE as if connected to MEDLINE.

DOCLINE was designed to provide health professionals with information quickly. In order for this service to be effective, it is important for participating institutions to receipt incoming requests daily and to update their status indicating action taken within four working days.

Only the citations taken from MEDLINE that are included in the HEALTH database correspond to the Unique Identifier (UI) that is needed for inputting ILL requests into DOCLINE — These records have the acronym MED in the Secondary Source (SI) field. The UI from other sources in the database cannot be used for DOCLINE requests.

The American Hospital Association is a DOCLINE participant, and the LIBID is 60611A.

Caryl Scheuer, the chair of the MHSLA interlibrary loan committee, has developed a two-part, ten-page list of Michigan medical libraries which includes their MISHULS code and their LIBID. The first part is alphabetical by hospital; the second alphabetical by MISHULS code. These packets will be mailed within the next two weeks.

Caryl also reports that she has arranged for CE credits for the DOCLINE workshops and will be mailing out the certificates shortly to all who requested credit. Caryl and Dave Keddle (head of the union list committee) have also arranged for Kim Goldman of GMRMLN to return a short DOCLINE session at the annual meeting. These two committees, which have been operating as one large 'document delivery' committee, are also planning to publish guidelines for and holding workshops in structuring DOCLINE cells. Both Caryl's interlibrary loan committee and Dave's union list committee have been working very hard to ease our entry into DOCLINE and the results have been widely praised by MHSLA's membership.

Caryl and Dave will ensure that DOCLINE responds to Michigan's needs and problems, but they must have that documentation, so keep doing those request histories. Please report any problems with DOCLINE immediately and send your printouts or a letter about the problem to Caryl Scheuer at Hutzel Hospital, to Kim Goldman at GMRMLN, and to DOCLINE.
