This newsletter contains the 1988 Interlibrary Loan Statistics reported by MHS LA libraries. Borrowing and Lending activities are reported separately and, as a point of interest, have been calculated as Docline activity and Total activity.

An alphabetic list of members submitting statistics and their data is also included. Those libraries that did not count specific data are indicated with a N/R in the data field.

Libraries should keep in mind the specific questions asked on the 1989 survey, so that 1990 statistics can be reported accurately.

Collection size data was reported in several different ways so the information was not useful for this report. The Committee would like to know how many current subscriptions your library has, including free subscriptions.

The age of the collection is also helpful. If your library was established in 1970, but the bulk of your subscriptions were started in 1980, then your collection is essentially 10 years old.

The 1989 Interlibrary Loan Statistics are due now, so please fill out the enclosed statistics form and return it to:

# Computers in Libraries '90

A Review

This year's conference finally addressed the concerns of the "Special Library". One entire track of the program was devoted to medical and law libraries. Looking at the Conference from a one-person-library perspective, however, I found the Conference still dealing with the larger library. Many of the speakers, although addressing the medical aspect of computers in libraries, were connected with universities or were from institutions with over 800 beds. The Conference used to be called "Small Computers in Libraries." A more appropriate title would be "Small Computers in Large Libraries."

Still, the program was quite interesting. Highlights included CD-Rom products and services, Local Area Networks, the Library Macintosh, Expert Systems, Software Utilization & Training, Integrated Online Library Systems, Workstations, HyperCard (both for the IBM and the Apple/Mac), and Electronic Mail.

Yes, Virginia, there are HyperCard applications for the IBM. They are, however, not as visual as those for the Apple systems. From their presentations, I personally found them requiring more work in programming than database software.

Although several of the sessions dealt with use of generic software for library applications, only two discussed fully integrated systems. The sessions on the individual applications were quite interesting and provided different perspectives of basic library tasks that could be incorporated into my own system.

One of the most exciting papers dealt with the use of CD-Rom for a cooperative catalog among a large group of libraries in Northwestern New Jersey. The system was derived from OCLC records and includes a couple of colleges bringing the records to over one million on one CD.

This year's sessions were tape recorded. If you are interested in purchasing a copy of the conference proceedings or a list of available tapes, you may contact Meckler Conference Management at 11 Ferry Lane West, Westport, CT, 06880.

The exhibits this year were predominated by CD-Rom products and services. Library specific software vendors were also there. What was absent, were Fax applications, in spite of the new technology dealing with plain paper and laser printers.

All of the Medline on CD-Rom vendors were there to demonstrate their wares, along with some new products such as LC-MARC subject headings on CD.

As in the past, I found this Conference to be a wealth of ideas for future systems in my own library. I think it is perhaps one of the most fascinating that I have attended which deal with the library field.
