APME Graduate Survey: 2002
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#### **Abstract**

The purpose of this project is to update the AMPE Graduate Surveys conducted in 1991 and 1996. It is our goal to update current practice management statistics to graduates of the class of 2001 and to follow up on the previous information provided by the class of 1991. The survey for the class of 2001 asks specific questions concerning mode of practice, location of practice, financial well being and future plans. The survey for the class of 1991 revisits the questions and responses that were given in the 1991 AMPE questionnaire. These surveys will provide more current and accurate information concerning the present state and future direction of the optometric profession.

### Methods

The original AMPE survey used for the study in 1991 and 1996 was revised and sent to all members of the graduating class of 2001 from the Michigan College of Optometry (MCO). The survey to the class of 2001 is very similar to the original AMPE surveys so that statistical comparisons and conclusions can be made. The survey was given in multiple choice/fill in the blank format with a final section for additional comments. All questions dealing with mode of practice, location of practice and influence on decision making asked for specific answers from each of the responders. Questions concerning income and timing of current and past modes of practice were scored according to a range. The survey was mailed on two separate occasions in order to increase response numbers. A similar survey was sent to the class of 1991 that asked questions that would reflect any change in mode of practice, location, and financial well-being for practicing optometrists in the first decade of their careers.

### Results

Forty-six out of the sixty-four surveys were completed; 20 from the class of 1991 and 26 from the class of 2001. All responses to the individual questions have been tabulated and are included in the following table.

#### Discussion

The first topic of comparison deals with mode of practice. More Optometrists are self-employed from the class of 1991 versus the class of 2001. This difference is not unexpected given the financial situation/debt of most new graduates. Comparing the number of employed optometrists we find that more graduates of 1991 are employed by optical chains (42%) while more graduates from 2001 are employed by Optometrists (29%), Ophthalmologists (25%) instead of optical chains (18%). Fifty three percent of the class of 1991 reached their present mode of practice within one year, while 74 percent indicate they are practicing in their desired mode.

Eighty percent of the graduates surveyed from the Michigan College of Optometry named Michigan as their state of origin and over 70 percent are presently practicing in Michigan. The class of 1991 showed a more even distribution among city sizes, while the class of 2001 located primarily in medium sized cities (10,000-100,000). Those graduates who located in states other than Michigan show a random pattern of distribution.

Most graduates (70 %) of the class of 1991 anticipate being in their current mode of practice for five or more years. Only 35 percent of the graduates from 2001 anticipate being in their current mode of practice for 5 or more years. For their ultimate mode of practice the class of 1991 indicated that 64 percent wished to be self employed, while 36 percent desired employment by others. Fifty eight percent of the 2001 graduates desire to be in some form of private practice, while 42 percent desire to be employed. Half of the total number surveyed anticipates reaching their ultimate mode of practice in five or more years.

For the first year after graduation the class of 1991 reported an average annual income of \$60-\$70,000, while the class of 2001 reported an average annual income of \$80-90,000. For the last year in practice the class of 1991 reported an average annual income of \$100-110,000. Sixty eight percent of this class reported their salary as a good indicator of responsibility.

### Conclusion

The prevailing mode of practice continues to be self-employment; however, the initial mode of practice data indicates a shift from corporate employment toward associate and multi-disciplinary practices.

Graduates from the Michigan College of Optometry continue to locate and practice in Michigan.

Ultimately a majority of graduates from both classes desire self-employment and anticipate practicing in that mode in four or more years. Conversely, the graduates from both classes seeking employment primarily prefer optical chains as their ultimate mode of practice. The average annual income has remained relatively stable given a decade of economic change. In general those Optometrists who responded to the survey reported a high level of personal and professional satisfaction.
