Observations during administration of the VIPA

- 1. Child's posture
- Does the child keep their paper straight in front of them or do they turn it. (VMI)
- 3. Pencil grip
- 4. How darkly does the child make their lines? (VMI)
- 5. Are they slow and deliberate at their attempts or are they hasty? (VMI)
- Does the child have a memorization strategy? If so, what is the child's memorization technique? Do they recite aloud to themselves or quietly? Do they utilize the entire time allowed to stare at the card/page or do they look away after only glancing at the presented item? Do they demonstrate "chunking" or grouping of letters or numbers? (Letter sequences, VADS)
- 7. During the MFFT, does the child carefully study the pictures before making their choice or do they randomly point?
- 8. Does the child turn their head or use their finger to keep their place while reading? (DEM, DRS)
- 9. While reading (DRS), does the child completely skip unknown words or do they attempt to sound them out? Make note of complete mispronunciations versus word exchange (ie substitute a word that has similar letters in it for the correct word). Does the child miss tenses?
- 10. Make note of the time to complete the DRS.
- 11. Observe the child's handwriting and any reversals of letters or numbers.
- 12. Is the child alert? Are they fatigued by previous tests? What is the overall mental attitude?
