Ferris State University Student Stabbed at Off -Campus Oakwood Apartment Complex

Ferris State University's Department of Public Safety was made aware of an off-campus stabbing incident that occurred on Sunday, Feb. 23 at the Oakwood Apartments on 14 Mile Road southeast of the Big Rapids campus.

The incident, which is currently under investigation by the Mecosta County Sheriff's Department, occurred between 2 and 3 a.m. on Sunday, Feb. 23.

The stabbing victim is a Ferris student who has been treated and released by the Spectrum Health Big Rapids Hospital. The suspect is currently at large and is described as a 6-foot, 170-pound Caucasian male with medium-length brown hair, a scruffy and lighter-colored beard, who was wearing a white hat with a different colored brim. The suspect was believed to have used a pocket knife with a two-to three-inch blade in the stabbing. The identity of the suspect is currently unknown.
