Ferris Students to Receive Michigan Campus Compact Award for Community Service

LANSING – Six Ferris State University students will be recognized by Michigan Campus Compact for their dedication and commitment to community service. The students will receive their awards during the 18th annual Outstanding Student Service Awards Celebration on Saturday, April 12 at the Kellogg Hotel and Conference Center in East Lansing.

Each year, MiCC awards students from member colleges and universities across the state for their outstanding commitment to service-learning and civic engagement. Three types of awards are given: the Outstanding Community Impact Award, the Commitment to Service Award, and the Heart and Soul Award. This year, more than 500 students from 34 member campuses will receive awards.
