Discussions included:

The annual MDMLG Wayne State University student scholarship: the scholarship announcement has been sent out and we are awaiting applications.

MDMLG is sponsoring two upcoming CE classes:

- A PubMed "train the trainer" class in April this is a mixed format class with both online and classroom training over four sessions. The class is full and there is a waiting list.
