Popular comedian and New York Times best-selling poet Bo Burnham will perform Wednesday, Sept. 23 as part of Ferris State University's homecoming activities.

Student homecoming committee comedian liaison Bryan Hinrichs said there was considerable effort made to secure Burnham as headliner for the Homecoming Comedy Show, and he's hearing positive feedback about the event.

"It's just pure excitement. This is one of the larger names, and people are recognizing it. We did put in some work to get the allocation for it," Hinrichs said. "We hope it really excites people for Homecoming."

Burnham was only 18 when he became the youngest person ever to record a half-hour Comedy Central special. The second of his hour-long comedy specials, "what.," has more than eight million views on YouTube. Burnham's book of poetry, "Egghead," was published in October 2013.

Hinrichs said that the committee is excited by their lineup for the show, and expect it will be a memorable event for "Home is Where the Dawg Is," the 2015 Homecoming theme.

"We're trying to bring back this Ferris pride. We're hoping to get people really amped, that's why we went for such a great name," Hinrichs said. "We're hoping the excitement follows through for the whole week."

The Ferris Homecoming Committee has noted that tickets will be required to see the Homecoming Comedy Show. Tickets will be issued, one per person the day of the show, starting at 5 p.m. at the Williams Auditorium ticket office. Up-and-coming comedian Brandon Wardell will open the Homecoming Comedy Show at 7 p.m. in Williams Auditorium. The show is for mature audiences only.
