BIG RAPIDS, Mi.--Ferris State University students, faculty and staff who are current or past members of the military are invited to the annual Veterans Day breakfast on Wednesday, Nov. 11. The event will begin at 8 a.m. in Rooms 202 B and C of the University Center.

Ferris' Veterans Coordinator Adam Forbes said that the breakfast is sponsored by President David Eisler's office. He added that veterans from the greater Big Rapids community are encouraged to attend.

"We're a really community-oriented campus," Forbes said. "President Eisler has been pleased by the turnout in years past. It's a chance to honor service members, including those who have retired."
