## 1. Summer Recruitment Camp Planning

Tracy Powers and Raymond Gant gave an overview of their units' summer technology camps held this past summer. The Minority Affairs summer technology camp was funded through the King/Chavez/Parks College Day Program, with an approximate cost of \$6,000 for 60 students. FSU-GR sponsored a summer technology camp for 4-5 Grand Rapids area schools with an approximate cost of \$4000 for 80 students

After Robbie Teahen related other planning ideas for summer camps as well as dates for upcoming camps, it was determined that a master calendar is needed for coordination. Dan Burcham will convene a small team comprised of a representative from FSU-GR, UCEL, Admissions, along with Raymond Gant. The team will bring back a proposal for Deans' Council review at a later date.
