PCAF Consultation

The committee sought for clarification from the APAO for when a proposal requires a PCAF. This request was in reference to Proposal 17-106, DAGD Curriculum Tweaks 2017. UCC had requested that a PCAF be submitted since the proposal is adding more than three new courses. In his response, the program coordinator argued that UCC manual did not specify that a PCAF is needed for the creation of new courses within an existing degree program.
