The chair shared a list of concerns from the pre-UCC committee. Other concerns from members include:

- Too many learning outcomes per course.
- Unexplained acronyms which make it difficult for members to adequately review the proposal.
- Conflicting information on Form A and program checksheet regarding the number of clinical semesters required for graduation.
- Lack of explanation of what “poor credentialing success rates” mean.

A compiled list of concerns from the pre-UCC and UCC meetings is attached. The same list was also shared with the proposal initiator. It was decided that an invitation to discuss the proposal will be extended to the proposal initiator after the receipt of the requested information.
