Keynote Speakers: The committee has secured Dr. Thomas Ferrari, Assistant Professor from the OUWB School of Medicine, as the 2015 conference keynote to speak on mindfulness and its application to balancing our work with colleagues, students, physicians, and patients as well as in personal life. Mindfulness is "the intentional,

accepting and non-judgmental focus of one's attention on the emotions, thoughts and sensations occurring in the present moment."

CE Courses: The committee has two CE speakers who are interested and available and seeks Board approval to confirm them. To date, we have confirmed:

- Community Engagement 101 by Deborah Charbonneau (WSU) for 4 CEs.
- Emerging Technologies for the Busy Librarian by Gabriel Rios (Indianapolis) and Melissa DeSantis (Denver) for 4 CEs.

We are working with the GMR on availabilities of speakers for the following course, but also seek Board approval for the topic:

• *Measuring What Matters to Stakeholders* - Jacqueline Leskovec (GMR) – interested and working with fellow GMR colleagues to determine who can teach it.

The committee has one additional CE slot available. As we will be bringing in two outside speakers for the Emerging Technologies CE, we would like to select another GMR offering and seeks input from the Board about topics of interest:

- Will Duct Tape Cure my Warts? Examining Complementary and Alternative Medicine (4 CEs) – Samanthi Hewakapuge
- Chemicals, Drugs, and Genetics Oh My!: Searching PubMed and Beyond Holly Burt (currently a 6 CE online course see if it can be converted to 4 CE face-to-face)
