1. Proposal Summary The summary is generally less than one page. Briefly state what is proposed with a summary of rationale, highlights and desired effective date:

This course utilizes an African-Centered approach to facilitate a service learning experience in Haiti. An Africancentered philosophy holds that everything in the universe is functionally connected, and individuals are viewed as an extension of the environment. This philosophical approach is utilized to create an understanding of the history and legacy of people of African descent in Haiti. It includes a 10-day, intensive international experience designed to deepen students' knowledge of the culture and social problems facing local communities in Haiti. It involves an examination of global, social, and economic issues and responses used to address health, education, medical and social issues affecting a developing country. This course is organized around classroom discussions, community service projects, personal interactions, and recreational and cultural experiences. It is an interdisciplinary, collaborative experience open to advanced level undergraduate students in the social sciences, education and health-related fields and requires permission of the instructor.

This course includes three stages that incorporates historical foundation and application. The first stage will occur in classroom sessions prior to students' departure to Haiti. The five scheduled sessions will prepare students for travel abroad and cover content that will be critical to students' understanding and analyzing of the experiences they encounter in Haiti. Classroom lectures include a historical-cultural introduction to Haiti, an overview of the role of government and non-government social service organizations, and their responses to social problems.

The second stage focuses on application through hands-on practical experience. Students will visit specific localities including a school for children with disabilities, an orphanage, and a Catholic Church. These sites will expose students to aspects of social development from a government and non-government perspective. Students will have the opportunity to work directly with children and their families. Students will meet government officials, organizational representatives, university professors, and other individuals who will explain individual, local and international development efforts to address social, health and economic problems. Students will engage in daily group sessions at the end of each day while abroad. Using a reflective learning style, students will participate in daily group sessions to discuss their experiences. During sessions, students will be asked to share their thoughts and feelings about their interactions, observations and activities. Students will also reflect on their own personal growth and challenges.

The third stage involves cultural excursions and activities. Three days will be dedicated to visiting cultural and historical landmarks that are intertwined with Haitian culture, history, politics, and art. Students will explore Haiti's capital city, Port-au-Prince, surrounding mountains, sandy beaches, and nearby fishing villages. Students will learn about Haiti's Spanish, French and African roots and gain insight into the social, economic, and environmental impacts of the catastrophic 2010 earthquake.

This class was offered successfully as an experimental course summer 2017, and will be offered again this summer, 2018. We would like to offer this class as a regular elective offering beginning summer 2019.
