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I. Technology Road Show (presenters Bea Griffith-Cooper, Vicky Deur, Mary Holmes, Bill Knapp, Sue Cherry and Jody Gardei). Folder with relevant handouts provided

- MyFSU Vicky Deur reviewed the newest version of MyFSU introduced on May 17th. She demonstrated the new "1 click" feature for faculty in which they can navigate through Faculty Tools screens quickly. Within Ferris Connect updated screens also make it faster for faculty to navigate to desired screens. She pointed out that when a course is loaded in Ferris Connect students are added immediately as they enroll but names are not dropped from the roster if they withdraw and faculty have to manually go in the system and "hide" the names of students they do not wish to appear.
- FerrisConnect Mary Holmes reviewed "The 6 Top Tips & Tricks" handout with emphasis on Tip #1 using the Browser Check. When logging on to FerrisConnect, by clicking on the check browser link in the upper right-hand corner the system will run a browser check and identify where changes are needed (red check appears). By running this browser check most problems are identified and corrections can be made.
- WebEx Bill Knapp gave a brief demonstration of this useful conferencing tool, citing its many possible applications and ease of use. Ferris has approximately 100 licenses and suggestions for colleges/department acting as "host" for the account was suggested.
- IT Support Sue Cherry and Jody Gardei reviewed technical support areas available but stressed the quickest way to obtain help is to start with the TAC support line X4822 which logs all calls into the system and dispatches assistance. 10-15 minutes is the goal to get assistance to a class in progress. Also ITAP brochure provided and system explained for providing technical training. Recommendation made to access ITS website at www.ferris.edu/techsupport for monthly newsletters and toll free number for off campus connection.
