- 1. Call to Order President Merle Rosenzweig called the meeting to order at 10:49AM.

The 2014 Education Committee had a busy year arranging for CE courses, speakers, and presenters at the annual conference. On Wednesday four CE classes were offered, two in the morning and two in the afternoon: Grey Lit: Google for It and More, Third-Party PubMed Tools, Introduction to Bibliometrics, and American Indian Health Information Resources.
