**Phi Lambda Sigma to conduct free health screening**

BIG RAPIDS – Another Ferris State University student organization is volunteering its time for community service.

The College of Pharmacy’s chapter of Phi Lambda Sigma, national pharmacy leadership society, will conduct a free health screening for members of the campus and local communities on Wednesday, April 13.

The screening will be held in the Pharmacy Building’s model pharmacy from 3 to 7 p.m. Phi Lambda Sigma members, with the assistance of Pharmacy faculty, will check cholesterol, blood glucose and blood pressure.

According to group spokesperson Leonard Warren, the screening can accommodate only 70 persons due to a limited number of test kits. He also noted that test results are most accurate following a nine-hour fast.
