Drummer Mark Schulman to perform March 21

BIG RAPIDS – World-class musician and cancer survivor Mark Schulman will bring his inspirational message to Ferris State University on Monday, March 21.

Schulman, who engages audiences with stories of success and survival through his personal association and performances as a drummer with some of the greatest artists of our time, will perform at 7:30 p.m. in the Rankin Center Dome Room. His appearance, which was rescheduled from the earlier FLEX Leadership Conference, is free and open to the public.

His performance credits include recent tours and recordings with Cher, Sheryl Crow, Destiny's Child, Foreigner, Heart and Billy Idol. He has also appeared on the Jay Leno, David Letterman and Rosie O'Donnell television shows, and has been likened to a combination of Tony Robbins, Lance Armstrong, Bono and Ringo.

Schulman's presentations feature engaging, high energy life messages, punctuated by his explosive drumming. He invites audience members to join him on the drums and relates his experiences and those of the artists he has worked with to empower his audience to reach their goals.
