Ferris Rube Goldberg Team Goes for National Championship

BIG RAPIDS – The road to the Rube Goldberg National Championship goes through the Granger Center. On Saturday, Feb. 28, Ferris' Rube Team will be taking on a new challenger this year in Central Michigan University. The regional competition takes place at 10 a.m. with the winner moving on to the National Championship at Purdue University on March 28.

Ferris won the National Championship in 2007, its third year participating in the competition. In their fifth year, they not only have the first place, but two second-place finishes, as well. The National competition has teams from Purdue University, University of Texas, Texas A&M, Penn State University, University of Toledo, and this year a team from Canada among others.

The team is composed of students from the College of Engineering Technology (CET). Many are in Mechanical Engineering Technology, Electrical Engineering Technology and Cad Drafting Tool Design; along with a mixture from other CET programs.
