CSI consultant to speak at Ferris

BIG RAPIDS – Dr. Gary Telgenhoff, a consultant for the hit CBS series “CSI: Crime Scene Investigation,” will be speaking at 7 p.m. April 11 in G. Mennen Williams Auditorium as part of the Arts and Lectures Series.

Telgenhoff also is employed as a forensic pathologist and deputy medical examiner for the Clark County Coroner’s Office in Las Vegas, Nev. He sees approximately 1,000 bodies per year, 450 of which he autopsies. Of these cases, 45 are homicides. His presence is often required in court with regard to his findings and determination of cause and manner of death.

Telgenhoff is Michigan born, growing up in Cadillac and attending Cadillac Senior High School. He then attended Spring Arbor College, where he earned a bachelor’s degree in biology and chemistry. From there, he earned a Masters of Science degree from Eastern Michigan University and attended medical school at Michigan State University.
