BUILDING PROGRESS. <u>East Building</u>: All terrazzo floors have been poured except for the stairs. <u>Terrazzo floors have been</u> ground down and ready for polishing in south and west wings. The hoist tower has been removed and the room on the top floor has been glassed in and bricked in. The lower tower floor in the tower room should have glass blocks completed by tomorrow.

In the one-story wings of East Building: electrical fixtures installed in all rooms but four; all rooms painted; doors hung and windows installed in five rooms; cabinet cases installed in all rooms.

West Building: Two-thirds of the lower floor has been poured. Brick wall to height of six feet laid for student lounge on first floor. On the east and north sides, exterior brick completed up to bottom of third floor. Steel roof beams installed for music room and music practice rooms. Steel roof beams are now being placed on the third floor.

MICHIGAN COLLEGE ASSOCIATION. Dr. K. G. Merrill, Vicepresident, represented Ferris at the fall meeting of the Michigan College Association at the University of Michigan on Thursday, November 1. Features of the meeting were addresses by Dr. G. M. Gilbert, M.S.C., who witnessed the war criminals trials at Nuremberg, and by Dr. Harlan Hatcher, new President of the University. Discussions were led by Dean Victor Rapport of Wayne and Dean Emil Leffler of Albion on the topics "Higher Education and Psychological War" and "College Credit for Courses, Study, and Experience in Military Service", respectively. Dr. Merrill reports that 90 people were in attendance, representing most of the colleges in Michigan.
