## PROPOSAL

## **International Education Committee**

Functions:

- 1. Promote global consciousness through a variety of activities.
- 2. Encourage faculty and student exchange between Ferris and other countries.
- 3. Coordinate an international festival of food, dance, song, and craft.
- 4. Be conscious of and proactive in regards to the concerns and issues of the international students on campus and provide advocacy for them.
- 5. Set criteria for and select the International Educator of the Year/International Student of the Year.
- 6. Serve in an advisory capacity on activities relevant to recruitment and retention of international students.
- 7. Host a reception to honor international scholars on campus.

Membership:

- 1. Two faculty and one academic administrator appointed by the Vice President for Academic Affairs (VPAA) for a-two year term.
- 2. Four faculty appointed by the Executive Committee of the Senate for a twoyear term.
- 3. The faculty and the academic administrator are voting members. They will elect a faculty chair every year.
- 4. Additionally, the International Student Advisor and the Coordinator of International Admissions will serve on the Committee as nonvoting ex officio members.
- 5. Every effort should be made to spread representation on the Committee across the different academic units.
- 6. Appointment to the Committee should be made such that to assure that membership is based on interest and expertise in the area of international education.
- 7. The Committee shall report to both the VPAA and the President of the Senate.

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
