

# PROPOSAL

## International Education Committee

### Functions:

1. Promote global consciousness through a variety of activities.
2. Encourage faculty and student exchange between Ferris and other countries.
3. Coordinate an international festival of food, dance, song, and craft.
4. Be conscious of and proactive in regards to the concerns and issues of the international students on campus and provide advocacy for them.
5. Set criteria for and select the International Educator of the Year/International Student of the Year.
6. Serve in an advisory capacity on activities relevant to recruitment and retention of international students.
7. Host a reception to honor international scholars on campus.

### Membership:

1. Two faculty and one academic administrator appointed by the Vice President for Academic Affairs (VPAA) for a two year term.
2. Four faculty appointed by the Executive Committee of the Senate for a two-year term.
3. The faculty and the academic administrator are voting members. They will elect a faculty chair every year.
4. Additionally, the International Student Advisor and the Coordinator of International Admissions will serve on the Committee as nonvoting ex officio members.
5. Every effort should be made to spread representation on the Committee across the different academic units.
6. Appointment to the Committee should be made such that to assure that membership is based on interest and expertise in the area of international education.
7. The Committee shall report to both the VPAA and the President of the Senate.
