I have carefully read the proposed new bylaws, noting changes in format, language and content as well as noting additions. I find the lay-out, ie "subject headings" or "cut lines" to be both informative and readable. I have no problem with major additions such as "removal from office" and tightening up on our dues paying. These are additions which reflect the seriousness of our purpose and endeavors.

I have found a few areas where I feel the language used is awkward or something is left out:

Article II. Officers (Continued)

Section 2. Vacancies

C. the following was left out when this paragraph was typed

Article V. Elections

C. (Each Member shall have three votes?) Shouldn't this read "Each Member shall vote for three candidates for Nominating Committee"

I commented on the following awkward language yesterday when I called you but will repeat for the record:

Article II. Officers (Continued)

D. should read as follows "of performing" instead of to perform. "for removing" instead of to remove. "Said officer" instead of that person.

I believe that MHSLA owes you a debt of gratitude for the tedious and difficult job you so willingly accepted in reviewing and making recommended changes in our bylaws.
