Ferris' Drake Named MSPE Higher Education Division Engineer of the Year

BIG RAPIDS – Chuck Drake, a Ferris State University professor of Mechanical Engineering Technology, was named the 2011 Professional Engineer Higher Education Division Engineer of the Year by the Michigan Society of Professional Engineers at the Michigan Engineering Conference hosted at the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel in Grand Rapids in June.

Drake was recognized by MSPE primarily for his work with MATHCOUNTS, a middle-school math competition, and for his engineering-related college student activities that include the Ferris Formula SAE student racecar project.
