## Ferris to Host Spiritual Exploration Fair

BIG RAPIDS – The Spiritual Exploration Fair at Ferris State University is a collaborative effort based upon the work of people from the Office of the Dean of Student Life, Wesley House, the Office of International Advising, My Sister's Keeper, and Student Leadership and Activities.

The fair is set for Friday, Sept. 9 in the Rankin Student Center Dome Room from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. It is free and open to the public. The event's primary goal is to help students with their spiritual development. This fair will be set up as resource event with tables hosted by spiritual student organizations from campus, local spiritual centers and places of worship, and underrepresented spiritual centers and places of worship from outside of Big Rapids.

"Nothing like this has been done at Ferris in the past, and we're excited to be able to offer this unique opportunity to our students," said Nicholas Campau, coordinator of Student Life at Ferris.
