BIG RAPIDS – Ferris State University Hospitality students gained valuable networking experience at the National Society of Minorities in Hospitality Conference, where a Resort Management major from Pinconning was named the 2012-2013 Midwest Regional chair.

Students traveled to Washington, D.C. for the February conference, where they attended panel discussions, workshops, networking suites with industry professionals and a career fair with more than 20 companies, including restaurants, hotels and resorts.

Other students attending were Christopher Dennis, a Resort Management major from Midland; Michael Miranti, a Hotel/Resort/Food Industry Management major from Forest Hills, N.Y.; Kyle Ottenhoff, a Resort Management major from Lake Orion; and Sean Reynolds, a Business major from Muskegon. Students do fundraisers to pay for their trip, Wolfer said.
