

MHSLA Bylaws Amendments
to be voted on at the
MHSLA Annual Meeting, October 14, 1982

Proposal to amend ARTICLE III, Section 2 of the MHSLA Bylaws.

Section 2. Area Group Representatives

A. Representation.

Each of the following area groups shall have one representative on the Executive Board; Flint Area Health Sciences Libraries Network; Metropolitan Detroit Medical Library Group; Mid-Michigan Health Sciences Libraries; Northern Michigan Health Science Library Group; South Central Michigan Health Science Library Group; South Central Michigan Health Sciences Libraries Association; Thumb Area Medical Information Consortium; Upper Peninsula Michigan Health Science Libraries Group; Valley Regional Health Science Librarians; Western Michigan Health Sciences Libraries Association.

Proposal to amend ARTICLE IV, Section 1 by adding new sub-sections.

Section 1. Standing Committees

D. Designation and charge.

3. MLA Liaison Committee.

a. The President of MHSLA shall be the MLA representative.

~~b. The MLA Liaison Committee shall establish and maintain channels of communication with MLA.~~

5. Education Committee.

a. The chairperson of the Education Committee shall be the representative to the MICCLE Organization.

b. The Education Committee shall advise and make recommendations concerning current information about education programs and opportunities to local health sciences library groups and others.

Proposal to add a new ARTICLE VII. Affiliation.

ARTICLE VII. Affiliation.

Upon approval by a majority of the voting membership at an Annual Meeting, affiliation or disaffiliation with a common interest organization may be made, provided that

1. The objectives of such organization shall be consistent with those of the Michigan Health Sciences Library Association.

2. The activities of such organization shall not be in conflict with the goals and activities of the Michigan Health Sciences Library Association.
