MHSLA Education Committee Statement of Purpose

MHLSA's Education committee proposes and plans the coordination of educational activities among MHSLA's local groups. Because the Committee focuses on the coordination of educational activities, the major concerns of the Committee include: 1) assessment of the educational needs of the MHSLA membership including number of and geographic location of interested members; 2) indentification of educational programs/resources that could meet these needs; 3) coordination of those educational programs which the committee reo recommends for state-wide presentation; 4) establishment of a liasion with the educational components of each local group; 5) promotion of any educational activity sponsored by MHSLA or any of its local groups; 6) identification of sources of continuing education credit for MHSLA sponsored educational activities. To enhance the educational programs/services for MHSLA members, the Education Committee supports cooperation with other agencies throughout Michigan that involved in continuing library education.
