zation at considerable time and expense and some recompense seems reasonable.

Norma Powers has asked the Nominating Committee to send her a letter verifying that she was approached to serve in an official capacity for the organization. Norma would like to use the letter as support for her request for a travel budget from her organization. We would like the Board's approval for this action.

The Nominating Committee would also like to suggest to the Committee on Bylaws that it consider changing the requirement that there be a representative from each area group nominated for the Nominating Committee. We suggest that eight names are too many to fill three positions and that a fair representation of the entire state could be achieved through some other method.

The Nominating Committee also suggests that the Board standardized the format for the biographical statement and the statement of aims requested from each of the candidates. This would enable a better comparison between candidates and would also give the candidate some guidance in preparing his statement.

If the suggested candidates are approved by the Board, the Nominating Committee will proceed with securing the consent to serve, the biographical statement, and the statement of aims from the candidates.
