Thank you for your letter of April 16, your kind remarks as to our progress in MHSLA were a ray of sunshine in my rather hectic day.

In response to your questions on the origin of the association logo, artists and background, I think I can give you a fairly comprehensive picture. However, for the full story, refer to: MHSLA Executive Board minutes for April 11, 1980 p. 2 and May 30, 1980 p. 3 finally Sept. 12, 1980 p.3.

The genesis of the idea of a new logo came from the Detroit Group - the person who first expressed the idea was not recorded in the minutes. However - it was not a committee who investigated potential artists but simply various Board members who volunteered. Also the idea of the contest came from the Board (Apr. 11, 1980). Robin Rand, Margo Dix and I all volunteered to find local (Michigan area) artists to submit designs. Robin was unable to contact anyone but contributed money towards the prize (\$ 50.00) The artist I contact is Monica Drukis. Her background is she attended the art institute at the Chicago Museum of Art and has worked as a professional designer in lithography and advertising for several years. She was a designer for Hammond Litho. in Northbrook, Ill. and Edwards Brothers, Lithographers in Ann Arbor. At the end of the conference in Bay Valley Inn, I gave her sample logos to you for the Archives. The second artist contacted was Nancy Fortino Bates. I do not know her background but she was contacted by Margo Dix. (Enclosed recent correspond. for the Archives).

I think that the Board minutes summarize the actions of the Logo design contest better than I can. Since it was not a committee per se we do not have a separate report.

As you know, Nancy Fortino Bates' design was the winner.

I am sorry I cannot provide you with the current address of Monica Drukis as she recently moved to Dexter, Michigan after residing in Ypsilanti. I do keep in touch with her and will send you her new address when I next hear from her.

It was so nice to see you at the Board meeting - I am looking forward to our Sept. board meeting in Saginaw when I will get to see my old friends again. Say hi to Mary and Addie.

I did not correct the attached sheet that you enclosed because it is essentially correct. Both artists received the same award (\$50) as we had promised them - win or lose.

I know that Mary will respond but have filled in the blanks, just in case on the attached.


