Groups, Teams, & Committees at FLITE Nomenclature & Terminology

Committee: a group of individuals who are identified to work together on an ongoing basis toward common goals; while membership of the committee may rotate, the charge remains the same.

Task force: a group that is formed to accomplish a large-scale task or important project within a specific timeframe.

Team: a group that works together in pursuit of shared activities as defined by the organizational structure.

Interest group: an informal collective that engages in loosely structured discussions and learning opportunities; functions without an official charge, timeframe, or membership.

Work group: a group of employees that work semi-autonomously on recurring tasks with a narrow focus; focus or tasks may shift as a result of changing trends or issues.
